Our group consists of totally 10-15 persons. We are men, women and children and represent the historic timeframe of the 9th and 10th century. The enactment is limited to Vikings and is focussed on Birka and Hedeby.

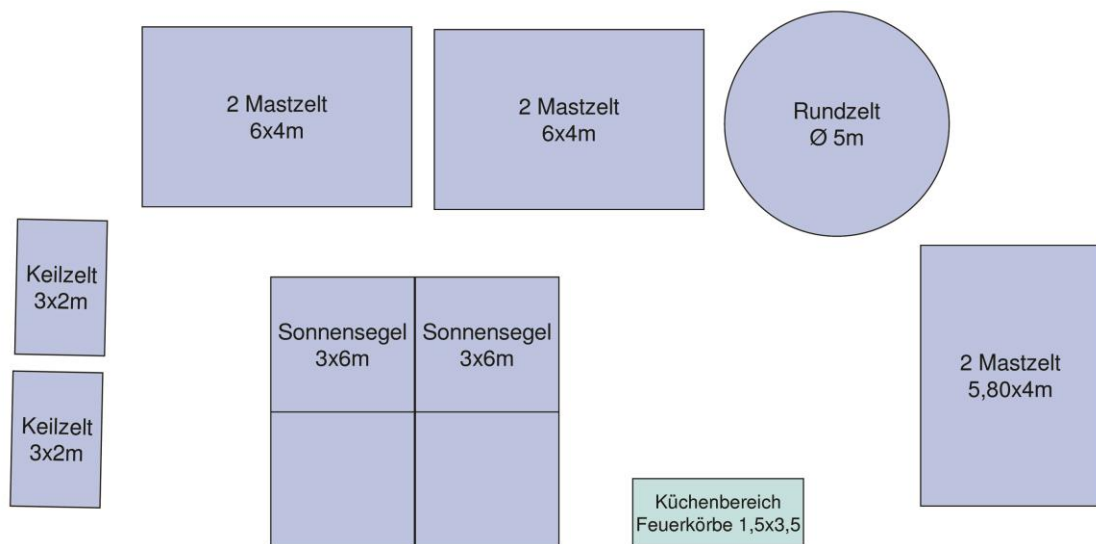
...: our camp

Depending on the number of participants, our camp consists of 4-8 medieval tents, a shade cloth and the camp kitchen.

By preference we camp in an area of 25m x 15m. For combat displays inside the camp, we require 7m x 7m additional space.

We open at least one tent up to visitors, displaying the inside content, such as traditional Viking bed, travel chest and more.

...: What we are doing during the entire day

Inside the camp we show the everyday commodities of a travel camp. There is medieval cooking, where we emphasise on trying authentic recipes, and we repair our equipment with historic tools.

On the border of our camp, our warriors train repeatedly with different historic weapons during the day. Visitors get explanations on the parts of armour, weapons and fighting techniques.
